

Assistant Lecturer in Clinical Skills/Simulation - School of Health, Social Work and Sport - Grade G

Job Description

Purpose

To play a key role in the continued delivery of Clinical Skills/ Simulation for all Student Paramedics in the context of emergency care and interprofessional provision.

To provide a clinical link between the Paramedic Science BSc programme and the Clinical Skills Team.

Duties

1. To contribute to students achieving the skills-based learning outcomes of modules within the Paramedic Science BSc.
2. To provide feedback to students through one-to-one tutorial sessions, or via Teams, on their clinical skills development/ progress.
3. To undertake administrative duties relevant to clinical skills planning and delivery (lab and simulation-based) as directed by the Module Leaders.
4. To promote student support to students where required.
5. To adhere to quality assurance and enhancement systems to ensure high standards are maintained and the student experience is enhanced.
6. To continue to develop their own teaching and learning skills.
7. To participate in the formative and summative assessments of students in terms of clinical skills.
8. To undertake any other duties relevant to the Skills Lab/ Simulation activities and commensurate with the grade, as directed by the Associate Dean or their representatives.
