

# Assistant Lecturer in Clinical Skills/Simulation - School of Health, Social Work and Sport - Grade G

Job Description

### **Purpose**

To play a key role in the continued delivery of Clinical Skills/ Simulation for all Student Paramedics in the context of emergency care and interprofessional provision.

To provide a clinical link between the Paramedic Science BSc programme and the Clinical Skills Team.

#### **Duties**

- 1. To contribute to students achieving the skills-based learning outcomes of modules within the Paramedic Science BSc.
- 2. To provide feedback to students through one-to-one tutorial sessions, or via Teams, on their clinical skills development/ progress.
- 3. To undertake administrative duties relevant to clinical skills planning and delivery (lab and simulation-based) as directed by the Module Leaders.
- 4. To promote student support to students where required.
- 5. To adhere to quality assurance and enhancement systems to ensure high standards are maintained and the student experience is enhanced.
- 6. To continue to develop their own teaching and learning skills.
- 7. To participate in the formative and summative assessments of students in terms of clinical skills.
- 8. To undertake any other duties relevant to the Skills Lab/ Simulation activities and commensurate with the grade, as directed by the Associate Dean or their representatives.
