

Principal Lecturer in Clinical Skills – School of Medicine & Dentistry – Grade J

Job Description

Purpose

Lead on the design, implementation and quality monitoring of the Medical Skills and Quality Car (MSQC) theme across Year 1-2 MBBS and MPAS. Develop and maintain key links with Phase 2 MBBS, MPAS, and relevant clinical course teams to ensure consistency and continuity.

Duties

- Provide Academic Leadership for the planning, delivery, teaching and assessment across Years 1 and 2 of the MSQC theme (including clinical and communication skills, interprofessional education, etc) in line with the module descriptors and governing body requirements.
- 2. Ensure coordination with Phase 2 staff to deliver an integrated, comprehensive, and current programme for MSQC.
- 3. Take responsibility for assessment within MSQC across Years 1 and 2, leading on item writing and selection, blueprinting, standard setting, and delivery of clinical assessments; quality assure content and process.
- 4. Strategic oversight of the design, delivery, and evaluate teaching and assessment
- 5. Work collaboratively within the school to develop research themes/knowledge transfer and apply knowledge acquired from scholarship and external activities into the curriculum, demonstrating innovation in curriculum development.
- 6. Support Phase 1 leadership in the overall management and leadership of Years 1 and 2 of the MBBS programme.
- 7. Provide direction, support and mentorship to the MSQC staff across Years 1-2, providing advice on academic and professional development in line with the requirements of the University.
- 8. Lead on resource mapping for the delivery of the MSQC theme such as teaching and assessment space, equipment, consumables, patient volunteers and teaching staff, managing growth, succession, and sustainability.
- Engage, in conjunction with the Phase 1 leadership, in ongoing and annual review and evaluation of the programme: lead on adaptation, innovation and improvement of the programme in response to feedback or changing circumstances.
- 10. Represent MSQC on appropriate committees within the School, with partner institutions and external stakeholders
