Job Description

Purpose

For L: undertake specific module leader responsibilities in Biology and related programmes, as appropriate

Duties

- 1. Lecturing at all levels of the academic programmes in the School including Foundation programmes.
- 2. To engage in course developments in the area of Biology.
- 3. Make a contribution to achieving the academic objectives of the Subject Group of Biosciences and the School
- 4. As a Senior Lecturer, undertake significant administrative, course development and course leadership responsibilities.
- 5. As a Lecturer, act as a module tutor for a number of identified modules.
- 6. Administer course registers, assessment records, learning programme and other records.
- 7. Engage with the recruitment of students onto courses and provide appropriate advice on progression and career opportunities.
- 8. Develop and consolidate contacts with relevant external organisations
- 9. Adhere to quality assurance and enhancement systems to ensure high standards are maintained and student experience is enhanced.
- 10. Attend local and national events on behalf of the University, in order to promote the University and its courses, and to enhance the profile of the division, school and University as a whole.
- 11. With regards to the nature of your role and its impact upon our students, make an active contribution to and support the improvement of the student experience
- 12. To undertake any duties relevant to the School's activities and commensurate with the level of the post, as directed by the Dean/Associate Dean of School.
