#### Job Description

#### Purpose

To contribute to the delivery and support of modules and practical sessions within the School in the areas of medical sciences, clinical skills and anatomy.

#### **Duties**

- To contribute to the delivery in a number of identified modules under the guidance of the Module Leaders. Specifically, this will include Anatomy, Clinical Skills, Biochemistry, and other Medical Science wet laboratory sessions.

- 3. To contribute to the development of module information packs, assignments and examination questions with assistance and support from the Module Leader.

- 5. To actively participate as a member of the teaching team, attending and contributing to relevant meetings and engaging in student recruitment.
- 6. To adhere to quality assurance and enhancement systems to ensure high standards are maintained and the student experience is enhanced.
- 7. To develop own teaching and learning and attend associated training and development courses.
- 8. Contribute to the organisation and running of field trips and project work.
- 9. To undertake any other duties relevant to the School's activities and commensurate with the level of the post, as directed by the Head of School.
