

# DCP Epidemiological Studies Supervisor (Dental Therapist) – School of Medicine and Dentistry – Grade H

#### Job Description

#### Purpose

To make a contribution to achieving the academic objectives of the School through teaching, course co-ordination and the development of research and knowledge transfer opportunities.

The post holder will provide clinical examinations, oral health instruction and advice to patients, carers, and others within the community.

#### **Duties**

- 1. To engage in the teaching and supervision of dental research programmes including but not limited to PHE and LCC epidemiological studies.
- 2. To undertake clinical supervision of students, both in the Clinical Skills Room and in a clinical setting (UCLan Community Dentists Limited), within scope of practice.
- 3. To take day to day responsibility for the organisation and co-ordination and delivery of epidemiological studies as advised by study administrative lead.
- 4. To undertake administration in relation to specified research/knowledge transfer activities.
- 5. To contribute towards curriculum development.
- 6. To engage in development activity in relation to hygiene therapy and training of the dental team.
- 7. To maintain clinical skills via contribution to patient treatment and care.
- 8. Working within a collaborative framework, to contribute towards the development of the School's emergent research portfolio.
- 9. To participate in research activity within an area of medical science or medical education.
- 10. To engage in commercial/income generating activity within area of expertise.
- 11. To work productively as part of a team to secure School objectives.
- 12. To undertake any other duties relevant to the School's activities and commensurate with the level of the post.
