

Insurance Manager – Financial Services – Grade H

Job Description

Purpose

To manage the University's insurance provision covering current and future needs. The role will ensure that the University is sufficiently insured and will manage insurance claims. The scope of the role covers the whole University including subsidiaries and associated organisations.

Duties

1. Manage all aspects of the University's insurance programme, including policy renewals, claims handling, and risk assessments.
2. Liaise with insurers, brokers, and internal stakeholders to ensure optimal coverage and cost-effectiveness.
3. Provide expert advice on insurance implications for contracts, projects, and University activities.
4. Maintain accurate records and ensure compliance with relevant legislation and University policies.
5. Lead on insurance-related audits and reporting.
