Job Description

Purpose

Working closely with the Program Leads and Postgraduate Lead in a collaborative setting, the postholder will provide oversight, quality management, assurance and evaluation of the Restorative Dentistry curriculum for the DClinDent and MSc programmes in Endodontology, Prosthodontics, Periodontology and Implantology.

Duties

1. To take the lead role in the development and teaching of Restorative Dentistry.
2. Ensure the achievement of excellent standards, excellent student and staff experience.
3. Provide oversight and calibration of staff involved in the teaching supervision and assessment of dental students.
4. Effective collaboration with strategic partners in the advancement and delivery of dental training.

6. Assist with student recruitment and retention.
7. To provide clinical teaching and supervision within the University's Dental Clinic.
