

BDSi Course Lead – School of Medicine & Dentistry – Grade Clinical Consultant

Job Description

Purpose

The postholder will lead on the provision of professional leadership and management of the BDSi course but will also be expected to liaise with the leads of the other professionally regulated courses in order to deliver an integrated approach to dental teaching.

Duties

1. Leadership and management of the BDSi course.
2. Ensure the achievement of excellent standards, excellent student and staff experience.
3. Assist the Head of Dentistry in the achievement of strategic objectives in the school, the wider university and the external environment.
4. Clinical supervision of students in the Preston Dental Clinic
5. Provide oversight and calibration of staff involved in teaching, supervision and assessment of dental students across placement locations.
6. Effective collaboration with strategic partners in the advancement and delivery of dental training, including secondary care and specialist leads.
7. Assist with the overall academic leadership within the School, ensuring the quality of teaching and learning, and assessment.
8. Help to promote the research and knowledge transfer agenda within the School using an evidence-based approach.
9. Oversee student recruitment and retention.
10. Undertake responsibility for the line management, recruitment, retention, development and performance of designated staff.
11. Assist the Head of Dentistry in managing the resources allocated to the School to the agreed plan and within budget at all teaching sites.
12. Accountable to the Head of Dentistry in assisting in the provision of assurance regarding professional body requirements.
13. Support the University's commitment to equality, diversity, and inclusion by fostering an inclusive culture through the recruitment, development, and retention of talent.
14. With regards to the nature of your role and its impact upon our students, make an active contribution to and support the improvement of the student experience.
