

Clinical Senior Lecturer in Periodontology – School of Medicine and Dentistry – Clinical Consultant Grade

Job Description

Purpose

To contribute to, and lead in, the areas of course delivery, course management and course development in the specialty area of Periodontology. To undertake research and knowledge transfer through scholarly activities. To provide clinical expertise, oversight, governance, quality management, quality assurance and clinical evaluation of the curriculum in Periodontology and in related programmes, as appropriate.

Duties

- 1. Take a lead role in the development of teaching of Periodontology at postgraduate level, including teaching and supervision within the University of Lancashire Dental Clinic, Preston.
- 2. Make a major contribution to achieving the academic objectives of the School through undertaking scholarly activity, research output and knowledge transfer activities.
- 3. Undertake significant administrative and course development responsibilities.
- 4. Act as a module tutor for a number of identified modules. Administer course registers, assessment records, learning programme and other records.
- 5. Engage with the recruitment and retention of students onto postgraduate courses and provide appropriate advice on progression and career opportunities.
- 6. Proactively develop and consolidate contacts with relevant external organisations.
- 7. Adhere to governance, quality assurance and enhancement systems to ensure high standards are maintained and student experience is enhanced.
- 8. Engage actively with regional, national and international strategic partners, including scholarly conferences, to advance dental training and to enhance the profile of the School and University as a whole. in the advancement and delivery of dental training.
- 9. With regards to the nature of your role and its impact upon our students, make an active contribution to and support the improvement of the student experience.
- 10. Undertake any duties relevant to the School's activities and commensurate with the level of the post, as directed by the Head of Dentistry or Dean of Medicine and Dentistry.
