## Job Purpose:

Working within a collaborative team environment incorporating the School at Preston, the 4 Dental Education Centres and Enhanced Training Practices, the post holder will take responsibility for academic teaching and the provision of chairside clinical supervision and training, ensuring adherence to curriculum / quality assurance. In addition, the post holder will take specific responsibility for the delivery of dental materials teaching and chairside supervision of students within the UCLan Dental Clinic

## **Main Duties and Responsibilities**

- To work closely with clinical colleagues and staff in the associated Primary Care Centres to screen patients, in order to ensure a steady supply of patients whose dental conditions are suitable for treatment by students and to facilitate parity of the students' clinical experience for the Clinical Dental Technology, BDS and Dental Hygiene & Therapy (DT) programmes.
- 2. To provide chairside clinical supervision and associated clinical teaching, collaborating closely with the Clinical Education Co-ordinator with regard to standard protocols and curriculum requirements
- 3. To take responsibility for the student treatment plans and overall management of and accountability for clinical care, including assistance and intervention in procedures, as deemed necessary
- 4. To ensure compliance with all clinical curriculum and quality assurance requirements.
- 5. To lead on teaching of dental materials across all undergraduate courses.
- 6. To maintain records of student progression and course evaluation.
- 7. To provide lectures, seminars and tutorials for all 4 years of the BDS course and to take part in the assessment of students.
- 8. To represent UCLan on relevant internal, consortium and external committees, as delegated by the Head of School, promoting collaboration between consortium members and partner NHS Trusts.

- 9. To work with the BDS Director of Programme and the DT Course Lead in developing the curriculum
- 10. To facilitate and contribute to problem-based learning and to act as PBL tutor when required
- 11. To act as a personal tutor
- 12. To participate in peer review
- 12. To help students of dentistry within the School understand professionalism and to develop a professional approach to their work.
- 13. To take part in the student admissions process including interviews
- 14. To contribute to School-wide teaching and learning activities, including DCP and postgraduate teaching
- 15. To promote inter-professional learning and collaboration within the School and University as a whole
- **16.** To assist in the promotion of dentistry within the School, raising its profile locally, regionally and nationally.
- 17. To contribute to the development of the School's research profile
- 18. To undertake any other duties relevant to the role and commensurate to the level of the post, as directed by the Head of Dentistry or the Head of the School of Medicine and Dentistry
