

Clinical Teacher - Pre-Clinical Teaching - School of Medicine and Dentistry - Grade - Clinical Academic Payscale - Lecturer Grade

Job Description

Purpose

Working within a collaborative team environment incorporating the School at Preston, the post holder will provide pre-clinical teaching, supervision and training for the BDS, CDT and DT courses.

Duties

- 1. To work closely with the pre-clinical Senior Clinical Teacher to ensure delivery of the pre-clinical curriculum.
- 2. To work closely with clinical colleagues and staff in the UCLan Dental Clinic to screen patients, in order to ensure a steady supply of patients whose dental conditions are suitable for treatment by students and to facilitate parity of the students clinical experience.
- 3. To provide clinical skills, chairside teaching and supervision, collaborating closely with the Senior Lecturer in pre-clinical teaching and Course Leads with regard curriculum requirements.
- 4. To take responsibility for student learning and pre-clinical operative work, including assistance and intervention in procedures, as deemed necessary.
- 5. To provide clinical supervision of students on-site on the Preston Campus and occasionally as need arises in our Dental Education Centres and our other clinical sites.
- 6. To provide feedback to students on all aspects of clinical skills.
- 7. To assist with maintaining records of student progression and course evaluation.
- 8. To provide lectures, seminars and tutorials for the early years of the course and to take part in the assessment of students.
- 9. To work with the Clinical Senior Lecturer in pre-clinical education to implement changes to the curriculum.
- 10. To facilitate and contribute to problem-based learning and to act as PBL tutor when required.
- 11. To act as personal tutor.
- 12. To participate in peer review.
- 13. Other duties which may be assigned by the Deputy Head, Students and Teaching from time to time relevant to the responsibilities within the role.
